- St Gregory's and St Joseph's Catholic Primary School, Bedford

In time Bishop Peter and the Diocesan Trustee expect all Voluntary Aided Catholic schools in Northamptonshire and Milton Keynes to join OLICAT. Initially OLICAT academies will educate around 5000 pupils.

St Thomas Catholic Academies Trust (STCAT)

This new Multi Academy Trust will be formed by the merger of St Alban Catholic Academy Trust and St Peter Catholic Academy Trust and contain the following academies:

- St Martin de Porres Primary School, Luton
- St Mary's Catholic Primary School, Caddington
- St Vincent's Catholic Primary School, Houghton Regis

- St Anthony's Catholic Primary School, Slough
- St Ethelbert's Primary School, Slough

In time Bishop Peter and the Diocesan Trustee expect all Catholic Voluntary Aided schools in Luton, Slough and Buckinghamshire to join STCAT. Initially STCAT academies will educate around 5000 pupils.
