He guides my way.**

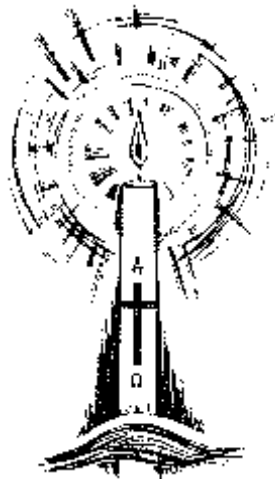
Thanks be to the Son
