Admission and Admission Appeals

Definitions

- **Catholic** means baptised in accordance with the rites of the Catholic Church, or enrolled in a baptismal programme.
- **Practice** means weekly attendance at Sunday mass.
- **Christian** means a member of the Churches Together in Britain and Ireland. A list of member churches can be found on the CTBI's website <http://www.ctbi.org.uk/AJE/226> However, because the list may occasionally change, it is recommended that 'Christian' should be defined as 'a member of one of the churches *in full membership with Churches Together in Britain and Ireland at the time when admission decisions are made.*'

Proof of church membership must be provided by the appropriate church leader.
